Paul : I'm busy, but I can't refuse it.

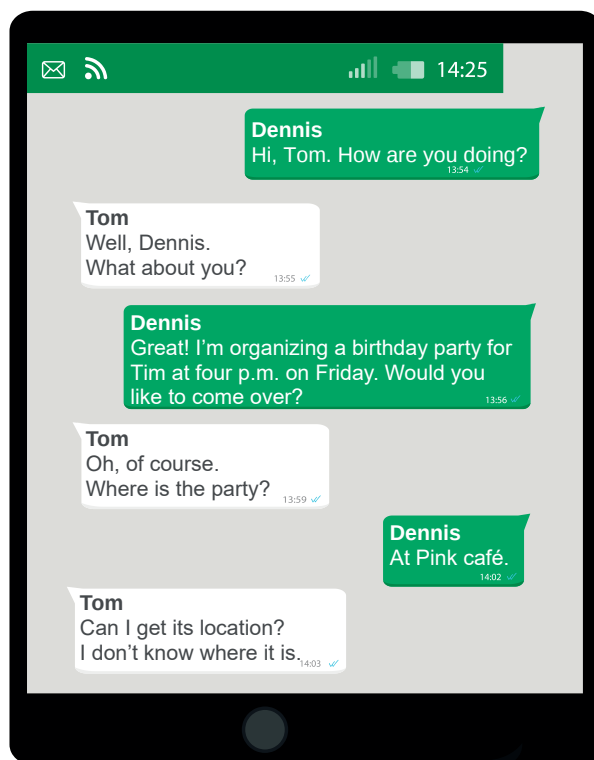
Molly : It sounds good, but I must finish my project.
